

Grading Table

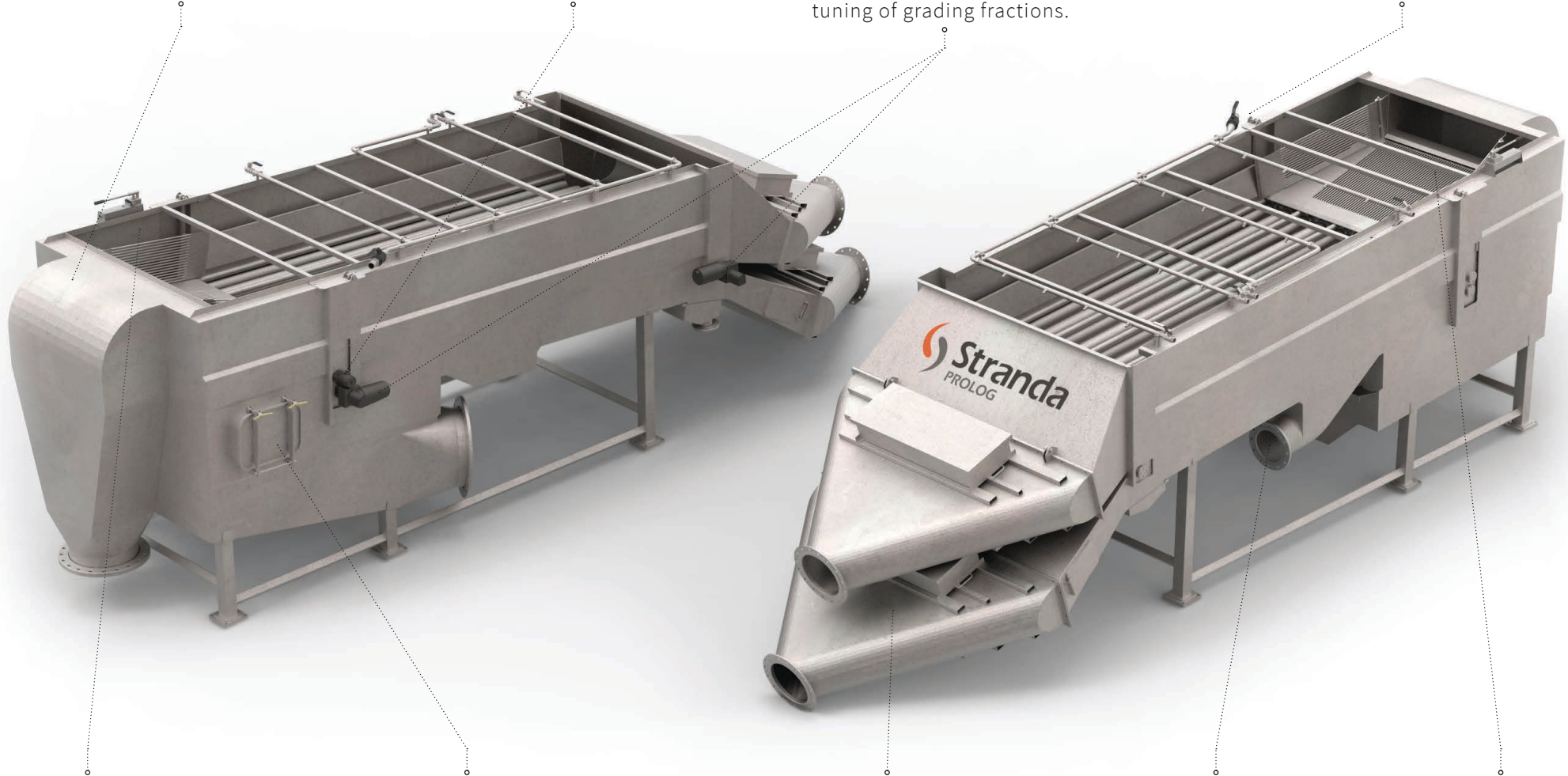


Flow gate slowing the flow of fish and water before it reaches the grading bars.

A hydraulic motor rotates the grading bars.

An electric motor controlled by a frequency converter for precise tuning of grading fractions.

Sprinkler system sprays a small amount of lubricating water over the grading bars.



The inclination of the grading bars can be adjusted.

Large manhole provides easy access for maintenance and cleaning.

Our grading tables are compatible with a wide range of fish counters.

Outlet for cleaner fish, smaller species etc.

High capacity strainer separates water and fish at the inlet.

Gentle grading

Stranda Prologs grading tables are designed with emphasis on efficiency, animal welfare and easy operation.

They can be built with one or two levels of grading bars. Two levels allow you to split one batch of fish into three fractions. Adjustments can be made manually by operators working by the grading table or remotely from touch screens in the wheelhouse.

The inclination of the rotating grading bars can be adjusted to regulate how quickly the fish slides across the grading area. This allows you to optimize the operation for a wide range of sizes.
